SUBJECT: Amendment of requirement to file copies of authorities

Reference is made to the Practice Direction on the Filing of Documents before the ECCC (ECCC/01/2007/Rev.7), Article 6.3, according to which "[d]ocuments shall be filed with copies of all authorities listed therein, with the exception of those documents listed in [the] ECCC Law Compendium hosted in the ECCC's official website."

The Supreme Court Chamber informs the parties in Case 002 that, like the Trial Chamber, it exempts them from the need to file copies of authorities, such as *ad hoc* Tribunal jurisprudence and well-known international instruments, that are already in the public domain and easily accessible by the Chamber and all parties. Authorities that are not easily accessible must still be filed with the Table of Authorities in accordance with the Practice Direction on Filing. All authorities must be listed in the Table of Authorities for ease of reference.
