Subject: Status of Your Civil Party Application

Your Civil Party Application form was received by the OCIJ Greffiers on the date indicated above and placed on the Case File No. 001/18-07-2007-ECCC-OCIJ under reference No. D25/2 on the same day. After analysis of your application by the OCIJ, you were informed through ADHOC of the possibility of joining another judicial investigation. Consequently, taking into account your response, your application was also placed on case file No. 002/19-09-2007-ECCC-OCIJ under reference No. D22/6 on 20/12/2007.

Accordingly, subject to any later decision of the Co-Investigating Judges (see paragraph 2), you are now considered to be a Civil Party in the judicial investigations relating to those two cases.

It should be recalled that the Co-Investigating Judges may, at any time during the judicial investigation, make a formal decision with respect to the admissibility of your application, and reject it if they consider that you are not a victim or that the criteria set out in the Internal Rules and in the Practice Direction on victim participation are not fulfilled. Such decision is opened to appeal before the ECCC Pre-Trial Chamber.

You should also be aware that, through your participation as a Civil Party, you may become aware of confidential information contained in the case file. Only the ECCC Judges can decide to make such information public. You are bound by the confidentiality

of the judicial investigation not to disclose such information, except personal information that you have provided to the judges in your application.
