- 1. **THE PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER** of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia ("ECCC") notes the judicial investigation initiated against KAING Guek Eav, alias "DUCH", in case file number 001/18-07-2007-ECCC/OCIJ and the forwarding of the case file to the Pre-Trial Chamber in accordance with Internal Rule 69(1).
- 2. It is noted that Ms. KIMARI Névinka has been accepted on 8 August 2008 (document number D25/26/5) as a Civil Party by the Office of the Co-Investigating Judges and has designated on 20 August 2008 Mr. KIM Mengkhy as her Cambodian co-lawyer, and Ms. Martine JACQUIN and Mr. Philippe CANONNE as her foreign co-lawyers, duly admitted to the list of lawyers willing to represent victims before the ECCC. Mr. KIM Mengkhy, Ms. Martine JACQUIN and Mr. Philippe CANONNE accepted this designation on 20 August 2008.
- 3. Rule 23(7) of the Internal Rules of the ECCC provides:

"Any Victim participating in proceedings before the ECCC as a Civil Party has the right to be represented by a national lawyer, or a foreign lawyer in collaboration with a national lawyer [...]"

4. The rights and obligations that apply as a result of designation as a Civil Party lawyer are set out in the attached document.

THEREFORE, THE PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER HEREBY ACCREDITS AND RECOGNISES Mr. KIM Mengkhy, Ms. Martine JACQUIN and Mr. Philippe CANONNE as the co-lawyers of Ms. KIMARI Névinka for the purposes of the judicial investigation before the ECCC.

Rights and Obligations of Civil Party Lawyers of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia (ECCC)

Participation in the judicial investigation: You are authorised to represent your client during his or her participation in the proceedings, as provided in the ECCC Internal Rules.

Access to the case file: You have the right to examine and make copies of the original case file of the judicial investigation to which your client is a party, as well as the paper and electronic copies thereof, during working days and subject to the requirements of the proper functioning of the ECCC. This access may be arranged with the assistance of the Victims Unit or the Case File Officer, but remains under the overall supervision of the competent Greffiers, as appropriate; Within reason, you may make, or request, copies of documents contained in the case file and take them to discuss with your client, but you must not hand over such copies to your client or to any other person.

Professional and Judicial Confidentiality: Through your client's participation as a Civil Party, both you and your client will have access to confidential information contained in the case file. Only the ECCC Judges and Prosecutors can decide to make such information public. You are bound by the confidentiality of the judicial investigation, the Internal Rules of the ECCC and your own professional rules not to disclose any information that you have gained from consulting the case file.

Filing of documents: Once your client has been recognized as a Civil Party, all official documents must be filed through the Case File Officer, as set out in the Practice Direction on Filing of Documents. You will receive electronic notification of documents placed on the case file, and you should provide an email address to the Pre-Trial Chamber greffiers for this purpose. Service of a hard copy will only be possible where you do not have access to email.
