SUBJECT: Request for update of risk assessment for Witness D14



1. Reference is made to the following strictly confidential documents:
 - WESU's risk assessment for Meas Kimsieu (Witness D14), dated 2 June 2009, and filed on 14 July 2009 (Document E105),
 - the letter sent by the President of the Trial Chamber to the Defence on 20 July 2009 (Document E40/2) inquiring whether the Defence still seeks to call Meas Kimsieu as a witness, in view of WESU's risk assessment, and
 - the Defence confirmation of the request to call Meas Kimsieu as a witness, dated 20 July 2009 (Document E40/2/1).
2. WESU is requested to inform the witness of the process applying to her appearance in court.
3. The Trial Chamber further requests WESU to update the risk assessment for Meas Kimsieu, and inquire with this witness if she indeed wishes to testify, as indicated by the Defence in its response.
