

## Khmer Rouge Tribunal Names Defense for 'Confidential' Suspect December 14, 2012

The Khmer Rouge tribunal named Friday two lawyers to defend a "confidential" suspect in Case 003.

In a statement, the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia said it had assigned Ang Udom and Michael Karnavas to represent the unnamed suspect.

The statement said the suspect was named in a second introductory submission by the international co-prosecutor to investigating judges in 2008.

But "the identity of any suspect named in the second introductory submission remains confidential," it said, adding that the suspect had claimed "indigence."

The lawyers named Friday are already defending Ieng Sary, the foreign minister in the Khmer Rouge regime.
