



Khmer Rouge Tribunal Faces New Financial Crisis

About 300 Cambodian staff at the Khmer Rouge tribunal will not get their December salaries and payments for locals will continue to be a problem in 2013, a spokesman said Tuesday.

Dim Sovannarom, public affairs chief at the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia, said sufficient funds from donors and friends of the tribunal had not been received.

He said there were no salary problems for the international side of the UN-backed court.

Expenditure is budgeted at \$45.7 million in 2012, of which \$10.3 million is for the national side, and \$43.9 million in 2013 which includes \$34.2 million for international side.
