

Khmer Rouge Defendant's Health Declining Stuart White September 13, 2012

Former Khmer Rouge foreign minister and current tribunal defendant Ieng Sary is back in the hospital after a string of recent health issues that have, at times, halted court proceedings, his defence lawyers confirmed yesterday.

Michael Karnavas, international co-counsel for Sary, said in an email to the Post that his client has been hospitalised since last Friday, but added that his ailments were "nothing serious".

On August 13, Sary's ailing health compelling the court to adjourn for the day.
