ECCC TO DISTRIBUTE PRINTED COPIES OF CASE 001 APPEAL JUDGEMENT TO S-21 SURVIVORS AND CIVIL PARTIES

The Public Affairs Section and the Victims Support Section of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia (ECCC) will start distributing printed copies of the Supreme Court Chamber Appeal Judgement in Case 001 to S-21 survivors and Civil Parties on **Friday 18 May 2012 at 13:30** at **Toul Sleng Genocide Museum**. Representatives of the media are invited to attend. In order to ensure easy access at the entrance to the Museum, representatives of the media are requested to carry in a visible manner their ECCC Accreditation Card or a press card issued by a journalist association or media entity.

Case 001 was the first case to be concluded before the ECCC. The case was concluded on 3 February 2012 when the Supreme Court Chamber sentenced Kaing Guek Eav alias Duch to life imprisonment for crimes against humanity and grave breaches of the 1949 Geneva Conventions. In an effort to make the appeal judgement more available for the Cambodian people, the ECCC has printed 5,000 copies of the Khmer language edition of the Appeal Judgement and 15,000 copies of the summary of the Appeal Judgement. These copies will be distributed to Civil Parties, domestic courts, universities, libraries and central and local government offices.
