ACTIVITIES RELATED TO THE PRONOUNCEMENT OF THE APPEAL JUDGMENT IN CASE 001 AGAINST KAING GUEK EAV

The information below applies to media representatives who have been registered and accredited for the Supreme Court Chamber's pronouncement of the judgment on appeals in Case 001on Friday 3 Feb 2012.

Press briefing on 2 Feb 2012 at 12:30 pm

The Public Affairs Section will organize a press briefing related to the upcoming pronouncement of the appeal judgment. The briefing will take place on **Thursday 2 February 12:30-1:15 pm in room 107** of the **ECCC Administration building**. Media representatives present to cover the hearing in Case 002 the same day will be escorted from the press room at 12:20 pm, whereas visiting media should be at the public entrance to the ECCC no later than 12:15 pm.

Pre-installment of equipment and reservation of space in the press room C105

Media representatives who wish to pre-install equipment and reserve desk space in the pressroom can do so between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm on Thursday 2 Feb 2012. As the Trial Chamber is conducting a hearing in Case 002 the same day, it will not be possible to reserve space and install equipment before 4 pm.

ECCC Accreditation Cards

Media representatives who have not yet collected their accreditation cards can do so between 12:15 and 1:15 pm and between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm on Thursday 2 Feb 2012, or by individual appointment. The accreditation cards can also be collected outside the ECCC public entrance from 7:00 am on Friday 3 Feb 2012.

Access to the ECCC on 3 Feb 2012:

Accredited media can access the court compound from 7:00 am on 3 Feb 2012.

The pronouncement of the appeal judgment

At 10:00 am, the President of the Supreme Court Chamber will read a summary and the disposition of the appeal judgment. It is estimated that this will take 1.5-2 hours.

Press conference following the pronouncement of appeal judgment

30 minutes after the Supreme Court Chamber has pronounced the appeal judgment, a press conference with court spokespersons, Co-Prosecutors, Defence Co-Lawyers and Civil Party Lawyers will be held in the public gallery. Audio and video stream of the press conference will be available in the media room, C105.

Media Services

The ECCC Public Affairs Section will provide facilities on the ground floor of the court building to assist the media during the court hearing.

The Press Work Room (C108) has a quiet space for working and a number of computers with internet connection will be available on a first come, first served basis. Please note that there is currently only a limited wifi network available at the ECCC, so media representatives are recommended to bring their own 3G modems if they need to upload or download large files.

Audio and video feeds of the court proceedings will be provided in the Press Room (C105). Television monitors will provide a transmission of the proceedings in English (room C105) and in Khmer (room C109).

Seats reserved for media in the public gallery

Media representatives should be in their allocated seats 15 minutes before the scheduled start of the hearing. No cameras, laptops, cell phones or recording devices will be permitted in the public gallery.

Handout Photography and Video Footage

The ECCC will provide high-resolution photography handouts from the start of the hearing, as well as video footage shot inside the courtroom and the public gallery. Handout photos will also be posted on flickr.com/krtribunal.

Audio

Audio feeds of the proceedings will be provided to media through a PHONO/XLR connection. This feed can be accessed in the press room (C105) using one of 48 audio connections (16 each in Khmer, English and French). Additional audio hookups are possible from recorder to recorder if the users bring the required cables. No audio recording will be permitted inside the courtroom.

Video

Video feeds of the proceedings will be provided through a BNC connection (PAL signal). This feed can be accessed in the press room (C105) using one of 30 output connections. Additional video hookups are possible from recorder to recorder if the users bring the required cables. No video recording will be allowed inside the courtroom.
