As we informed you earlier in our letter dated 18 May 2010, the *Avocats Sans Frontières France* Civil Party Co-Lawyers Group has the capacity to contribute to absorbing unrepresented Civil Parties in Case File No. 002, and bring its capacity to 1,500 cases.

Currently, the *Avocats Sans Frontières France* Civil Party Co-Lawyers Group is representing 1128 Civil Parties. We have been informed by the Victims Support Unit that 724 Civil Parties are still without legal representation.

We hereby reiterate our offer to represent those Unrepresented Civil Parties, and our capacity to absorb 300 additional cases.
