Deadline for filing supplementary information

We acknowledge receipt of your letters of 19 and 20 April 2010, in response to our Memorandum dated 9 April (D337/3) concerning the deadline for filing supplementary information in relation to the initial civil party applications.

After an in-depth analysis of the situation and in view, in particular, of the Memorandum of the Victims Support Section (VSS) concerning legal representation of the Civil Parties, we deem it necessary to allow Civil Party applicants more time for them, to, if necessary, file supplementary information in relation to their Civil Party applications in the light of the press release of 5 November 2009 regarding the seizure of the Co-Investigating Judges in Case 002.

Accordingly, applicants can file supplementary information to the VSS until 30 June 2010 in relation to Civil Party applications that had already been submitted to the VSS up to 29 January 2010.

Also, considering the need for Civil Parties to be represented by a lawyer who is able to have access to information relating to his **or her** clients and to **have the opportunity to be able to** offer them **considered legal** advice, we will issue an order, by 1 June 2010 at the latest, designating (temporary) lawyers for all those Civil Parties who are not yet represented, under the common legal representation system.
